PRINCESS NIGHT STREET OUTREACH

PARTICIPANT 3-12 hours/month Attend street outreach, lifting up the city in prayer, offering a rose and encouragement to the ladies we meet	FEMALE	MAKE CARDS Minimum of 30 minutes Create encouraging cards to be handed out to each woman we meet; guidelines provided	ALL
DOORMAN 3-6 hours/month Attend street outreach to help provide security for the outreach team while building respectful, hope-filled conversations with the men you encounter.	MALE	PRAYER WARRIOR Pray for special requests throughout the week	ALL

JAIL

PEN PAL 30 mins/week Once assigned a participant, you will write your first letter within 48 hours (your home address will not be used) and continue corresponding until she is released.	FEMALE	MENTOR 30-60 mins/week, in-person and virtual Once assigned a participant, you will meet with her either in-person or virtually dependent on the facility and offer hope and healing through mentorship	FEMALE
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FUNDRAISING

EVENTS TEAM MEMBER 15-30 hours/year Plan and implement large-scale spring and/or fall fundraisers (eg., golf event, gala)	ALL
EVENTS 5-10 hours/year Complete tasks necessary to implement event, help with set up and tear down	ALL
HOST THIRD PARTY EVENTS Organize and implement a fundraising event independent of The Freedom Collective (eg., yard sale, sports tournament, sale of goods)	ALL

EDUCATION

AMBASSADOR 3-6 hours/quarter Represent The Freedom Collective at events, answer basic questions about the organization; speak to churches, youth groups, community groups, etc. about human trafficking and how to get involved	ALL
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PARSONS DROP-IN CENTER

PROVIDE MEALS Minimum of 1 hour Provide a meal for guests at the drop-in center by preparing food in advance and dropping it off to be served during open hours. Volunteers can sign up for a date through our website	ALL	DROP-IN VOLUNTEER 4 hours/month minimum Serve with the drop-in center team by helping prepare the space, welcoming women, providing practical support, and creating a safe, caring environment where meaningful relationships can grow	FEMALE
DONATIONS 2-3 hours/month On the second Saturday of each month, help sort donated clothing and toiletries and restock the drop-in center with essential supplies	ALL		

SAFE HOME

HOTLINE Respond to hotline calls from women seeking to leave exploitation, complete an initial screening, and coordinate an exit team to safely transport them to the safe home	FEMALE	VOLUNTEER Share your knowledge and passions by teaching residents practical life skills, fitness classes, Bible studies, or other enrichment opportunities	FEMALE
RESPONSE TEAM When a woman contacts the hotline and is approved for admission, response team volunteers provide safe transportation to the emergency safe home. Each response team consists of one male and one female volunteer	ALL	MAINTENANCE Support the upkeep of the safe home through maintenance projects, repairs, and general property improvements	ALL

WITH THE EXCEPTION OF PRINCESS NIGHT OR PROVIDING A MEAL OR DONATIONS, ALL VOLUNTEERS WILL BE REQUIRED TO FILL OUT AN APPLICATION, PROVIDE A PASTORAL REFERENCE, HAVE A BACKGROUND CHECK, AND ATTEND TRAINING
